From the desk of the Lone Wolf General Manager – James Fargher

Welcome fans. It gives me great pleasure to welcome you to the debut of what will soon be the greatest promotion in the I.W.A., **the Lone Wolf League**. Those that have followed the IWA since the beginning will remember that I won the tournament to be named the IWA's first IWA World Champion in 1985. There are some who say that the IWA has gotten away from what made it great. A variety of the best wrestlers competing for the top title on a level playing field. A collection of personalities that grew the fan base and entertained audiences around the globe.

Here in the Lone Wolf League, we are providing an atmosphere that will be unmatched in the IWA, first the premium on championships will be great. The **LWL World Champion** will first defend the title against eleven of the best champions in the world. The LWL has worked out a deal with ten of the most successful promotions in the world. **The Continental, New England, Mid-Atlantic, Smoky Mountain, Central States, Pacific Northwest, Mexico, New Japan, European and Caribbean**. We didn't look at the size of the territory, we looked at the talent, since we know that together, under the LWL banner, we will all grow together. As a way to keep up with all of the great action, we have assigned a **Regional Correspondent** to report on the happenings in each of the territories with the **Regional Reports**. You won't find coverage like this anywhere else in wrestling.

Since the LWL's programming will be so crucial in helping the fans to see our World Class product, we will have, the **World Class TV championship**. The champion will defend his title against a different foe every week on our syndicated program, **Friday Night Fury!** I invite you all to tune into to the sneak preview of Friday Night Fury later on hosted by **Hugh Jass** and **IWA Hall of Famer Rick Challenger**.

My own involvement here in the LWL is as a facilitator and executive. I know some promotions prefer to use the management as a foil to their top stars to propel the action, but here in the LWL we prefer to let the wrestlers be the star of the show. Having said that, my position here is to maintain order and enforce the rules as need be. I don't like to suspend the talent, that only hurts the audience from enjoying the show, but I will hit em' where it hurts, the wallet. It is pretty hard to enter events when you are constantly being fined, so keep it exciting boys, but remember, we don't want to see the announcers, referees, and support staff injured or drawn into angles. The fans are here to see the best wrestlers in the world.

Another way we will give the fans action like they've never seen is by bringing them the greatest events in the world by hosting them right in the region they mean the most to. The European region will host the **King of the Ring Tournament** with the winner being allowed to refer to themselves as the King. The Mid-Atlantic, a haven for tag team wrestling will host the **Lethal Lottery Tag Team tournament**. Some events are not as 'family friendly' such as the Caribbean region's **Last Blood Battle Royal** where the last man in the ring not bleeding, wins. Other events, such as the **Parade of Champions, LoneStarCade, Superclash, the Great American Bash, the Mr. LWL tournament, the Clash of Champions** and some we have kept under wraps are all being set up to make the LWL the best it can be.

The **Wrestler Spotlight** gives the fans a deeper look at the stars of the LWL from the World Champion to the even some of the lesser known boys in the locker room who dark match material for years. The **Feud Scoreboard** will provide the fans with a summary of the rivalries and the win-loss records from their matches, which will put the cold-hard numbers out there for all to see. There is no where to hide in the LWL, so bring your best or go home.

At the end of the year, we will hold a banquet to recognize the **LWL's Annual Achievements** of the LWL's stars including the **Wrestler of the Year, Tag Team of Year and Six-man team of the Year** that will be determined by a points system. The system is simple to follow, **25pts for the LWL World champ, 15pts for the World Class TV title, 10pts for a Regional title, 5pts for winning the Battle Royal and 1pt for cutting a promo with trash talk or perhaps a sneak attack**. There will also be bonuses for winning tournaments, events and contests, but again, all of these will be easy to follow on our **LWL Official Ratings page**. Of course the Year-end Awards will include the **Most Popular, Most Hated, Inspirational, Comeback, Manager and Rookie of the Year** as voted by you, the fans of the LWL.

We want Lone Wolf Championship Wrestling to be a league for the fans, so we will have the **LWL Online Poll** results posted every month that you can make your voice heard. We asked fans across the World who they thought would be the first LWL World heavyweight champion.

Fans will no doubt enjoy the **LWL Online Store** which features some of the most fashionable clothing, fun stuff for the office and with the Holiday season around the corner you can find something for everyone on your list at the LWL Online Store.

FRIDAY NIGHT FURY – START YOUR WEEKEND OFF RIGHT, WITH HOT WRESTLING ACTION!

(The screen opens up with a shot of the Earth from space as stars sparkle. A deep voice announces “LONE WOLF CHAMPIONSHIP WRESTLING presents the greatest in professional wrestling from across the globe.” Each of the ten territory logos rush towards the screen while quick clips of various stars from each region wrestle, pose or point for the camera until the roaring of drums build up as the LWL logo fills the screen. “Welcome to... **FRIDAY NIGHT FURY!**”

(The screen shows a series of the ‘home’ arenas for the ten regional promotions until finally historic shots of Dallas, the Alamo, Houston and finally the LWL’s home arena for Friday Night Fury, **the Sportatorium** with it’s neon red letters glowing brighter and brighter as the camera zooms and turns the screen red.)

HJ: Good evening fans and welcome to Friday Night Fury. My name is **Hugh Jass** and I have the honor of announcing the action for the Lone Wolf League.

Let me tell you something, when LWL owner, **James J Steele** asked me to come out of retirement to join this venture, I jumped at the chance. Shocking!

RC: The real shock was you jumping at all. I bet you thought it was the pizza delivery guy’s GPS failed again and you wanted to wave him down, right?

HJ: Ahem. The man next to me, is a member of the IWA Hall of Fame and now my co-host as acting as color commentator, **Rick Challenger**.

RC: Is it going to be a problem? I mean, me a color commentator? I’m white. That’s okay, right? (Jass adjusts his glasses then turns back to the camera)

HJ: Fans, tonight’s first show is going to introduce you to the people who will be bringing you Friday Night Fury. The goal of this show is to spotlight some of the stars from the ten different regions while providing exciting action. Make no mistake this is a team effort. Our ringside interviewer, **Shooter Simmons**.

SS: Yo, yo, yo fans, Ahma here to let you know the straight dope from the stars of the LWL before and after, and who knows, maybe during a match. Boo-yah!

RC: Now HE could be a color commentator!

HJ: RC! C’mon now. In another bold move, we have imported the top locker room interviewer from New Japan, **Heidi Tanaka!** Howdy Heidi!

HT: Ohayoo gozaimasu! (giggles) Totemo koufun shiteiru yo! (giggles) Uhm, I am... happy... (giggles) Resuringu! Bonsai!!!

HJ: What? (RC looks shocked as Jass whispers to an off-camera producer) No. No. They told me she spoke English. How in the hell will she do interviews?

RC: To be fair, she can say that she is happy. This ought to go really super awesome fun-time excitement GO!

HJ: Now the fans here at ringside were allowed into get a sneak preview of the LWL. (camera pans ringside to show fans in LWL t-shirts cheering wildly. Just then an exceedingly buxom woman jumps over the ringside barrier, jogs to the ring and runs up to Hugh and Rick who are entranced by her curves.)

RC: It looks like I have finally met **Milena the Kissing Bandit!** My old **Badd Co.** tag team partner **Rick Riley** would love you, but go ahead, lay one on me...

(Milena looks at the camera, winks and then plants a big kiss on a stunned Hugh Jass, who staggers back as RC frowns. Milena waves at the fans.)

HJ: Goodness! (Jass face is red as he wipes away the lipstick and adjusts his hair) I’m married man. I’m a... Oh goodness. I didn’t know that she was-

RC: Whoa there stud. Look around. The fans have signs for you too. (camera shows a series of pro Hugh Jass signs.) Everyone loves Hugh Jass!

HJ: That may be, but I don’t want upset my wife, who hyphenated her name, **Opheilia Large-Jass!** My lil lady won’t like this one iota!

(The fans begin to cheer as scurrying down from the locker room is the LWL’s mascot, **Lobocito**, a little person wearing a mini-wolf costume, who runs into the ring, jumps around a bit and then scrambles after Milena who shrieks and runs away. Lobocito chases her to the locker room to fans chants of Lobo-cito!)

RC: What you just saw, ladies and gentlemen... is just a taste of the action you will see here in the LWL. Just ask this Hugh Jass!

HJ: Referees play a crucial role in the matches being fair and we have four of the most capable referees in the World. Please welcome our Senior Official, **Willy Wynne**, his son **Kenny Wynne**, **Frank Lee** and former IWA World Tag Team champion, **Nick Danger** who will really help enforce the rules in the ring.

RC: I like this crew of refs and I usually hate them all, but tell me, does Frank always have an extra large cup of coffee in his shaking hands?

HJ: The man likes his coffee and it may be why some of the boys in the locker room refer to him as Fast Count Frank! Now next we have a special treat, as one of the IWA’s most controversial figures, **Bodacious Brad Blaze** returns with his popular interview show, **Blaze’s Body Shop... right now!**

(The fans cheer as Blaze is seen sitting in the simple interview area that includes a coffee table. Blaze remains seated, rubs his jaw and lifts the microphone.)

BB: It has been a long time since I worked in this business, but when I was here, I had a habit of inciting promotions and fans. Often it was while I hosted **Blaze’s Body Shop** and gave wrestlers a chance to speak their mind. Sometimes that means deafening silence, but my first guest has a lot to say and has a lot of mysteries wrapped around him. He comes to the LWL with a beef with **The Tennessee Madman**, please welcome, **The Arabian Dream Ali Atari!**

(Eight women clad in black burkas walk out to Blaze’s interview area making two rows of four. They throw rose petals from small gold baskets in a bah from the locker room to the chair. Next, until the final woman in a black and silver burka walks out spraying a mist into the air that Blaze waves aside, when finally walking out in a three piece silk suit and designer sunglasses struts **Ali Atari** to a mixed reaction from the fans. He takes a deep breath of the mist and sits down.)

BB: I want to start off by asking if some of these rumors about you are true. Were you really trained by multi-time **IWA World champion Sheik Yerbutti?**

AA: (in a thick Arabian accent) Thank you for having me Meester Blaze. It is true. I was trained by Yerbutti. My family asked me what I wanted and growing up on the IWA, I knew I had to be trained by the best so that I could one day rule the IWA. He trained four of us in Dubai, but only I have made it this far..

BB: Who are the other three that trained with you? Is there any chance we may see them in the LWL someday?

AA: Bah! I did not agree to come her to talk of those who are dead to me. I have ruled Caribbean Pro Wrestling and now that I can compete in any of the ten LWL territories. One moment, women! Massage me! (the 8 women begin to massage as he sits.) Much better. Now, I have been scouting them all to get an edge on the competition and this is the reason why I have decided to target this Tennessee Madman. He is a perfect example of all that is wrong with this country. Drunken. Classless. Uneducated. (the fans begin to boo Atari) Listen to them Blaze. They should applaud me for my efforts, but the ignorant masses would rather chant U-S-A, U-S-A and elect corrupt officials who would rather argue over how to put out the fire than just team up to extinguish it. Let me show you what true power looks like. **Lady Xanadu!** (the woman in the silver and black burka produces a contract) This contract has changed one of the matches that was to be held at the next Friday Night Fury. It was to be The Tennessee Madman taking on **Nicholas St. Nicholas**, but not it will be a handicap match. This will prove my cunning and superiority. Some say 2-on-1 is a mistake, but it will send a message to the entire LWL that no one... will forget.

(Lady Xanadu begins to use a hand fan to cool off the now heated Arabian Dream. The fans begin to chant for Ali Atari to get in the ring and wrestle.)

BB: That is certainly a bold move. Now these fans certainly want to see you in the ring. Do you think we can see you in the ring tonight?

AA: How typically American. You fans got free T-Shirts, hats and tickets to the next show, but not good enough. You want to see me wrestle? Tune in next week. Come see me beat down that fool **Skittles** in Puerto Rico. There will be many stars in the LWL, but I will shine the brightest.

BB: Speaking of stars, rumor has it that that your father is not some wealthy Arab, but a IWA superstar, so not to get all Maury on you, but who is your Dad?

AA: Bah! I will not dignify such a question with an answer. Women! (the women stop massaging him and lift him to his feet) This interview... is over!

(Lady Xanadu fans Atari with a hand fan as he walks over towards the fans to shoo them away until the women make a new path of rose petals for him to leave.)

BB: That’d be all for Blaze’s Body Ship. Join me next time, when my guest will be the man who was old school before it was cool... **Wrestling Gold!**

HJ: That was quite an interview and fans, you can expect more interviews just like that and, well from what I hear, worse. Blaze like’s to push buttons.

RC: He always was good at that. I once saw him get a Priest to jump the railing and attack him. Sounds like Friday Night Fury will be quite a ride.

HJ: You betchya! Fans be sure to look check out the LWL store, follow us on Twitter @riley1d20 and now, a peak at our next show.

JAMES J. STEELE – OWNER OF LONE WOLF LEAGUE CHAMPIONSHIP WRESTLING

As a sideline reporter he interviewed Coaches, Players and Celebrities, now in the he will get post-match reactions from the LWL superstars.



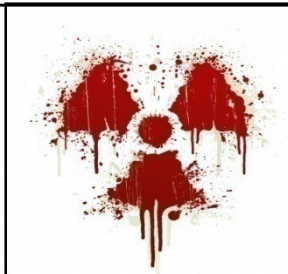
**LOBOCITO
